

## COLLEGE CREDITS FOR PELC GRADUATES

2016

Two Ohio universities grant college credits for PELC graduates: Franklin University, Columbus, and Tiffin University.

### FRANKLIN UNIVERSITY, COLUMBUS

### TIFFIN UNIVERSITY

A total of 6 semester hours of credit may be granted towards our Bachelor of Criminal Justice (BCJ) or Master of Science (MS) program if the student fulfills the requirements set out below:

1. The student must be admitted to the BCJ or MS program.
2. The student must complete the entire PELC program and submit a copy of the certificate to Tiffin University.
3. The student will need to submit their collection of PELC documentation (10-15 papers completed during PELC) and/or write one 10-12 page paper on an assigned topic related to the Tiffin University courses for assessment of credit.
4. Students awarded Undergraduate (BCJ) PELC credit, waive Graduate (MS) credit eligibility.
5. The student must pay \$100/per course for a total of \$200 for the 6 semester hours of credit.
6. The assigned faculty member will be paid \$150 to review the paper.

**Master of Science (Graduate):**

JUS525 Legal and Ethical Issues in Criminal Justice 3 credits

JUS610 Justice Administration Policy Formulation & Analysis 3 credits
