



ASSESSORS NEEDED

In April, 2015 Governor John Kasich established the Ohio Collaborative Community-Police Advisory Board to oversee the implementation of the recommendations from the Ohio Task Force on Community-Police Relations. The Ohio Association of Chiefs of Police and the Buckeye State Sheriffs' Association will be partners in this important process. In August 2015, the Collaborative made recommendations on two minimum standards for police agencies in the following areas:*

- Use of Force and Use of Deadly Force
- Hiring and Recruiting

Assessors will be employed for Ohio law agencies seeking certification to verify that:

- Standards were adopted
- Knowledge and awareness of the policy exists
- Proficiency is required
- Compliance has been accomplished
