RE: Certified Law Enforcement Executive (CLEE) Board Annual Report 2018-2019

The Certified Law Enforcement Executive program completed its twenty-third class during the past year and we have just started CLEE XXIV with 32 students. Thirty-two officers completed CLEE XXIII, and were certified at graduation ceremonies conducted on February 8, 2019. A total of 478 executives have now graduated since the inception of CLEE.

The CLEE Board continues to be actively involved in providing oversight of the program. During the past year:

- ➤ The CLEE recruitment DVD-- "Benefits of CLEE to the Individual, Agency, and Community" and word of mouth continues to attract attention to CLEE as evidenced by positive enrollment growth over the past five years.
- ➤ Thanks to the concerted efforts of past presidents, as well as Donna Harrass, Chief Executive Officer, a partnership was forged between OACP, BSSA, State Highway Patrol, and the Department of Public Safety. The current class is the fifth to study at the Academy. A key result is the continuation of the DPS grant to LEF for 2019 that provides CLEE tuition-free, as well as room and board at the highway patrol academy facility. The academy staff continue to be responsive hosts and make CLEE feel very welcome.
- ➤ Chief Michael Kallai, CLEE (deceased 2010) Award for academic excellence and community service was presented to Chief John A. Jones, CLEE, City of Oxford Division of Police of the CLEE XXIII class.
- > The CLEE web site remains updated with a fresh new look and an easier way to navigate.
- ➤ We continue to have the commitment from Franklin University and Tiffin University to provide graduate level credits toward a Master's in Public Administration degree.
- > Sixty-one graduates were recertified from Classes II, V, VIII, XI, XIV, XVII and XX this year.
- > Seventeen CLEE graduates were awarded Lifetime CLEE Status upon retirement.
- ➤ The CLEE curriculum continued to be updated with new content and instructors. We welcomed Dr. Thomas Meloni, Western Illinois University, to our faculty. Dr. Meloni teaches the Vision, Mission, and Guiding Principles module.
- ➤ In addition, the board approved a new module effective with the current class. The new module is titled, *Practical Leadership Models for Law Enforcement Executives*. The board is pleased to welcome Chief Gene Ferrara to the CLEE faculty. Chief Ferrara will teach this new module.
- > The board decided to eliminate the *Managing and Leading the External Environment* module.



➤ We continue to have representation on the CLEE board from the Ohio State Highway Patrol. The patrol's new superintendent, Colonel Richard Fambro continues to serve on the board.
