

Medway Drug Enforcement Agency Director

The Medway Drug Enforcement Agency Council of Governments, General Assembly, is seeking an experienced law enforcement professional to serve as the Director of the Medway Drug Enforcement Agency. The Medway DEA was founded in 1974 and is one of the oldest drug task forces in the State of Ohio. Medway is a Council of Governments and is funded through a county-wide tax levy. Medway is the only law enforcement agency in Wayne County, Ohio, that specifically investigates drug trafficking organizations and other drug-related crimes. All Medway Agents are certified through the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy and commissioned through the Wayne County Sheriff's Office.

Medway's primary mission is the arrest and conviction of drug dealers and suppliers, the seizure of illicit and controlled substances, and to identify all those persons who sell, manufacture, possess or use controlled substances in Wayne County.

The Medway Director serves under the general guidance of a governing board consisting of the Wayne County Prosecutor, Wayne County Sheriff, and Police Chiefs from Wooster, Orrville, Rittman, and Doylestown. The Medway General Assembly consisting of the Mayors of Wooster, Orrville, and Rittman, a County Commissioner, and a village/township representative, is the ultimate appointing authority for the Director Position.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Ten or more years of law enforcement experience
- Five or more years of supervisory experience
- Certified or previously certified as a Peace Officer by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Council (Must be able to obtain OPOTA Certification)
- Ability to successfully complete and maintain annual Firearms qualification
- A valid driver's license issued by the State of Ohio. (Must meet insurability guidelines).

Preferred Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in law enforcement, criminal justice, or other related field
- Graduation from advanced training such as the FBI National Academy, Southern Police Institute's Command Officer Development Course, Northwestern School of Police Staff and Command, or other advanced leadership development programs
- Previous budget preparation experience
- Previous law enforcement experience, specifically investigating drug cases
