- Safety Forces Stipend - \$1,350.00 annually
- Firearms Proficiency Allowance - \$900.00 annually

FILING DEADLINE

A completed application with all applicable documentation must be submitted by Thursday, April 6, 2023 at 3:00 pm. Completed application packets can be emailed to civilservice@auroraoh.com or dropped off in person at Aurora City Hall, 130 S. Chillicothe Road, Aurora, Ohio 44202 between 9:30 am - 3:00 pm.

WRITTEN EXAM

Saturday, April 15, 2023 at 9:00 am at The Bertram Inn and Conference Center, Amphitheater Room, 600 North Aurora Road, Aurora, Ohio 44202. Photo ID is required. A minimum passing score of 70% is required.

PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST

Immediately following the written exam, approximately 12:30 p.m. at 102 E. Garfield Rd, Aurora, Ohio 44202. The physical agility test will consist of a timed pass/fail obstacle course. The course will include sprints, stairs, fence climb, cone drill, and weighted dummy drag. Candidates who pass the agility test may be considered for interview, additional testing, and possible conditional offers of employment.

ADDITIONAL CREDIT

Additional credit will be given to candidates with a minimum passing score of 70% on the written exam. A maximum of 20% extra credit will be awarded. ***All Documentation for additional credit must accompany the application.***

10%	Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy Certification
10%	Honorable Discharge from the U.S. Armed Forces (minimum 6 months)
10%	Bachelor’s degree in applicable field
5%	Associate degree in applicable field
5%	Minimum of twelve (12) consecutive months service in an equal or superior position with another governmental agency

All conditional offers of employment shall be subject to a polygraph exam, psychological exam, background check, post-offer pre-employment physical exam, and drug screening. All offers of employment are conditional and subject to a probationary period of one (1) year.
