Civil Service

The Tipp City Police Department operates under Section 35 of the Charter of Tipp City. The Civil Service Commission operates under Ohio Revised Code 124 and Chapter 36 of the Charter of Tipp City. All entry-level qualifications are established by the Civil Service Commission.

Probation Period

All new employees have a one year probation period, and a 12 to 16 week Field Training program.

Personal Leave

Thirty-six hours of personal leave per year.



Vacation Leave

Vacation leave is accrued each pay period. Based on prior service vacation leave varies:

- 1-6 years: 80 hours per year
- 7-13 Years: 120 hours per year
- 14-22 Years: 160 hours per year
- 23-Retirement: 200 hours per year

Holidays

Ten paid holidays observed per year.

Sick Leave

Employees earn ten hours of sick leave per month.

Retirement

REQUIREMENTS

- Twenty-one (21) years of age
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license
- Citizen of the United States of America
- Residency requirement of 35 miles from Tipp City
- Must be able to perform the duties of the position
- Candidates will be expected to participate in and pass a qualifying physical agility exam, written



examination, and medical examination, including a drug screen.

- OPOTA Certified Officers are desired but not required. The City of Tipp City is an equal-opportunity employer.
